INFORMATION FOR PASSENGERS FROM NON-EU AND NON SCHENGEN COUNTRIES

Due to the introduction of the new Entry/Exit System, passing through passport control in Terminal 1 may take longer than usual. We kindly ask passengers to proceed to passport control without delay after check-in in the terminal. International Václav Havel Airport Prague is situated on northwest part of Prague next Kněžves and Přední Kopanina. The personal transit to the airport is provided by buses of PIT and by the special bus AE (Airport Express).

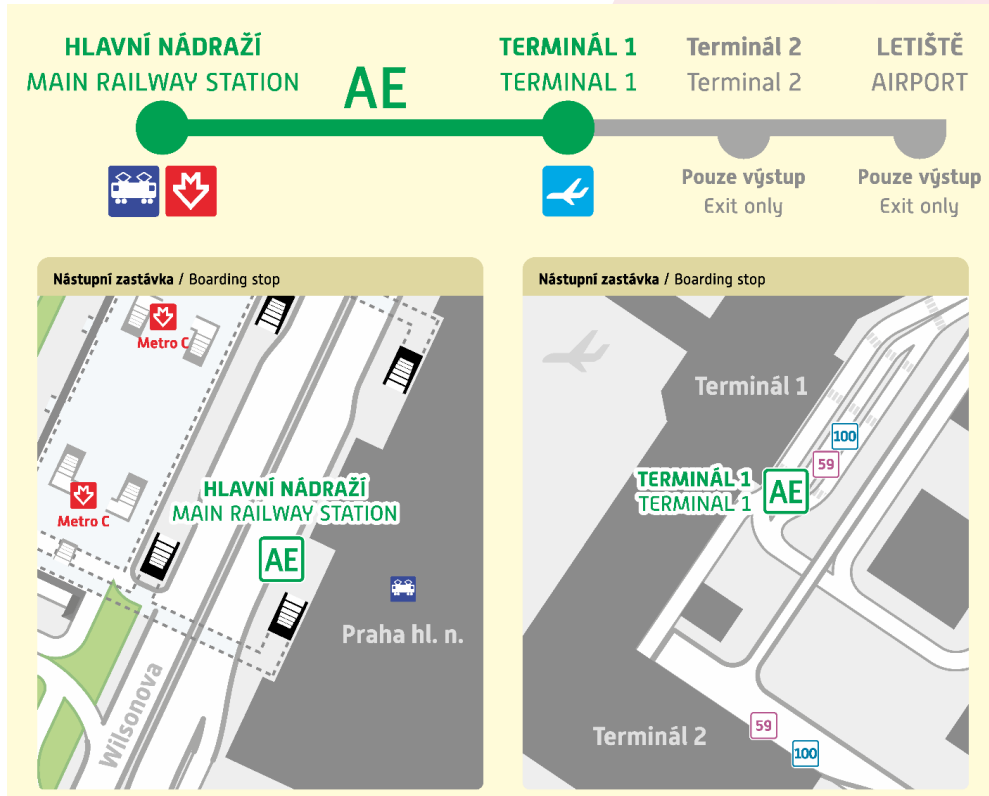

Special bus line that ensures direct connection of air, railway, and public transport by low-floor buses (with extended luggage storage space), operating continuously throughout the day.

→ Interval: 20–30 minutes, at night 60 minutes.

In the direction of the city centre the line does not stop in the Terminal 2 stop.

INFORMATION CENTRES AT PRAGUE AIRPORT

Information centres of the Prague Public Transit Company offer all information regarding the operation of public transport, lines routing, timetables and the tariff.

Scope of services provided:

- Information regarding the Prague Integrated Transport, the tariff and the Transport Terms of Service
- Sale of line timetables, maps and publications
- Sale of single-journey tickets for 30 and 90 minutes, 24 and 72 hours, Airport Express
- Sale of all electronic fare
- Sale of PID cards and paper coupons with optional beginning of the validity

Leaflets about the coming and currently ongoing suspensions and changes of the line routing, as well as some other current information materials, can be obtained for free.

OFFICIAL AND ALTERNATIVE TRANSPORT SERVICES

Official Taxi Service: Uber Airport

Use the [Uber app](#), self-service kiosks in the arrival halls, or service counters at both terminals.

The price is fixed and guaranteed in advance regardless of traffic or route length. Vehicles are parked directly in front of the terminals for immediate boarding.

Base fares start at approximately 40 CZK, with typical rides to the city center costing around 700–800 CZK (approx. € 28–32).

Alternative Apps: Bolt and Liftago

These services do not have stands directly in front of the terminal exit, but they are popular alternatives.

Private Transfers and Dispatch Centers

AAA Taxi: A traditional Prague dispatch center available 24/7. You can book by phone at +420 222 333 222 or via their app.

Safety Tip: Never accept ride offers from individuals who approach you inside the terminal. Always use official apps, kiosks, or marked taxi stands to ensure a safe and transparent experience.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT TRAVELLING

Why to use public transport and DPP services?

- **Fast and efficient transport** – short intervals, fast connections and suitable transfer links
- **Cheap and available** – fare for as little as CZK 10 per day (applies if purchasing the annual coupon for zones 0 and P)
- **Dense tram network** – by tram from the uptown to the centre of Prague
- **Short intervals** – the metro intervals start at 135 seconds, buses and trams run in 3-minute intervals on some lines (times apply during rush hour)
- **Barrier-free** – 45 metro stations, more than 900 buses and over 350 trams
- **24/7** – DPP services are available to passengers 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year
- **Day and night** – night connections in Prague are ensured by dozens of lines
- **Ecological** – vehicles meeting EURO 6 emission standard, as well as hybrid, battery or partial buses and trolleybuses
- **For entertainment as well as culture** – DPP ensures connection to important tourist objects and is an important partner in the field of socio-cultural events
- **Contactless** – in the metro, trams and suburban lines you can use contactless payment cards when paying the fare

Half price | **Seniors from 60 years until 65 years** bearing a valid proof of their discount entitlement (ID, passport).

Seniors from 65 years of age travel in the area of Prague for free, if they are able to prove their age (ID, passport).

Discounts

Prague Integrated Transport system (PID) offers fare discounts for the following categories of passengers:

- **Children up to 6 years** – free of charge. Such child must be accompanied by a person older than 10 years.
- **Children from 6 to 10 years** – in Prague free of charge
- **Children from 10 to 15 years** – in Prague free of charge, if they are able to prove their age.
- **Juniors from 15 to 18 years** – in Prague discounted season tickets, if they are able to prove their age.
- **Students from 18 to 26 years** – in Prague discounted season tickets
- **Seniors from 60 to 65 years** – in Prague discounted tickets, if they are able to prove their age
- **Seniors from 65 years** – in Prague free of charge, if they are able to prove their age
- **Accompanying a child up to 3 years** – in Prague free of charge, if they are able to prove the age of the child

Passengers must prove that they are eligible for the discount (ID, passport, PID Lítačka...)

If passengers cannot prove eligibility, they must purchase a full-price ticket.


Where to buy tickets

Tickets with time validity up to 3 days (72 hours) are available in **classic paper form** or **electronic form in the Lítačka app**.



The Prague Visitor Pass is available in two formats. Choose either a **physical card (Pass)** or an **electronic version (e-Pass)** in your smartphone.

What you should know:

- The Prague Visitor Pass is valid for 48, 72 or 120 consecutive hours once activated.
- If you purchase the Prague Visitor Pass online, you will receive a redeemable voucher electronically via email. Either print it out or save it on your phone. Present the voucher at one of our pick up points to receive your physical Pass.
- Present your activated Pass at the ticket office of each experience and receive a ticket to the venue. Don't forget to keep your ticket! Each site can be visited only once. Students aged 15 to 25 years (inclusive) must show a valid student ID card.
- The Prague Visitor Pass serves as a ticket for unlimited travel on public transport (excluding trains) during its validity period. It is not valid for use on suburban and commuter buses and trains outside of the city centre. Children up to 15 years of age are eligible for free travel on the public transport network. However, proof of age must be presented if requested by a transport inspector.
- As a free bonus, you will receive an easy-to-read printed map of the city with a complete list of experiences to help you orient yourself in the city.
- Once you activate a physical Pass, it cannot be exchanged for an electronic e-Pass (and vice versa)

HOW TO GET FROM THE AIRPORT TO THE OFFICIAL CONGRESS HOTELS

Hotel Pytloun Old Armoury Hotel:

- **Trolleybus No. 59:** Take this bus from the Airport to the Nádraží Veleslavín station (Green Line A).
- **Metro A (Green Line):** Take the metro in the direction of Depo Hostivař and get off at the Malostranská station.
- **Tram No. 12, 15, 20, or 22:** From the Malostranská stop, take any of these trams to the Hellichova or Újezd stop.
- **Arrival:** The hotel is about a 3-minute walk from here.

Hotel Vienna House By Wyndham Andel's Prague:

- **Trolleybus No. 59:** From the airport (Terminal 1/2), take trolleybus No. 59 to the Nádraží Veleslavín station.
 - **Metro Line A (Green):** Transfer to the metro and travel to the Můstek station.
 - **Metro Line B (Yellow):** Transfer to Line B (direction Zličín) and get off at the Anděl station.
- OR**
- **Bus No. 191:** This bus runs directly from the airport to the Na Knížecí / Anděl stop.
 - **Arrival:** The hotel is located a short walk from the metro station.

Hotel Casear:

- **Bus No. 100:** Take this bus from the Airport to the terminal station Zličín (Metro B).
- **Metro Line B (Yellow):** Transfer to the metro in the direction of Černý Most.
- **Arrival:** Get off at the Karlovo náměstí station (take the exit toward Palackého náměstí / Myslíkova) or the Národní třída station.
- **Walking Distance:** The hotel is located approximately 300–500 meters from both stations.

Barceló Occidental Praha Five:

- **Trolleybus No. 59:** From the airport terminals, take the trolleybus to the Nádraží Veleslavín station (Metro A).
- **Metro Line A (Green):** Transfer to the metro and travel to the Můstek station.
- **Metro Line B (Yellow):** Transfer to Line B and travel to the Anděl station.
- **Arrival:** The hotel is located approximately 350 meters from the metro station.

Hotel William:

- **Trolleybus No. 59:** From the airport (Terminal 1 or 2), take the trolleybus to the Divoká Šárka stop.
- **Tram No. 20:** Transfer to tram No. 20 (direction Sídlíště Barrandov) and get off at the Tyršův dům stop.
- **Arrival:** The hotel is located just a few steps from the tram stop.

Hotel Roma Prague:

- **Trolleybus/Bus No. 59:** Take this from the Airport to the Nádraží Veleslavín station (Metro Line A).
- **Metro Line A (Green):** Continue by metro to the Malostranská station.
- **Tram No. 12, 20, or 22:** Transfer here and get off at the Hellichova stop (located right by the hotel) or the Újezd stop.

HOW TO GET FROM THE AIRPORT TO THE CONGRESS VENUE TYRŠ HOUSE

- **Trolleybus No. 59** (from Terminal 1 or 2) to the Nádraží Veleslavín station.
 - **Metro A (Green line):** Take the metro in the direction of Depo Hostivař and get off at the Malostranská station.
 - **Tram No. 12, 15, 20, or 22:** From the Malostranská stop, take any of these trams to the Hellichova or Újezd stop.
 - **Arrival:** Get off at the Hellichova stop. Tyršův dům is located just a few steps from the stop (it is closer than the Újezd stop).
- OR**
- **Bus No. 100:** Take this bus from the Airport to the terminal station Zličín (Metro B).
 - **Metro Line B (Yellow):** Transfer to the metro in the direction of Černý Most and travel to the Anděl station.
 - **Tram:** Transfer to tram No. 12, 20, or 97 (direction Malá Strana) and get off at the Hellichova stop.
